DRAX ANT KIL GEL

Ant bait gel.



Drax Ant Kil Gel is a sweet based ant bait gel containing 5% Boric Acid as an active ingredient (9 g/Kg Boron as Boric Acid).

The product is available in 37 g cartridges suitable for use in most common bait guns. Boric Acid at correct concentrations is an ideal active constituent for use in ant baits as it is slow acting which is important for social insects like ants. The delayed toxic effects allow sufficient amounts of the bait to be transported by workers and then fed via trophaxis to other ants in the colony. This will ensure population reductions occur across all the different castes in a colony. Depending on the size of the colony and the success in getting a large number of workers feeding on the bait one to three applications is usually sufficient for complete elimination of a colony providing baiting techniques, bait quantity and placement as outlined below are carefully observed.

SOME TIPS FOR USING DRAX ANT KIL GEL

- Formulation available for both sugar and protein feeding ants
- Product is ready to use and must not be mixed with any other product or solvent.

- Elimination of other food sources may greatly improve the effectiveness of the product.
- Place baits directly onto ants nests or foraging trails as well as around areas where they are regularly observed. Use lots of small bait placements. Ants are often repelled by large bait placements. Baits should be 2 cm long and 2 - 3 mm thick.
- Ensure there is sufficient baits for all foraging ants to have adequate opportunity to feed.
- Do not spray baits or ants with any chemical during the baiting cycle.



- Increased ant activity may be observed once baits are placed due to the attractive nature of the product.
- Feeding may stop after 12 - 24 hours. This is normal.
- Results may take time to become evident. (Up to 10 days)

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For use to control Pharaoh Ants in all Domestic, Commercial and Industrial Premises.

Restaints: DO NOT place baits in areas that are regularly washed as this will remove bait.

INDOORS: Apply gel indoors in areas where ants are seen such as behind refrigerators and stoves, around water pipes and I cracks and crevices. Renew at monthly intervals until the desired level of control is achieved.

OUTDOORS: Where ants are seen entering the building, place small pea sized baits along walkways, directly on ant's nests and in cracks and crevices around windows and doors. Renew at monthly intervals until the desired level of control is achieved.

PRECAUTIONS WHEN USING DRAX ANT KIL GEL:

- Do not place in areas accessible to children or pets. If necessary use child resistant baiting stations such as the Termatrol GPX 2000.
- Do not place in areas where washing operations may transfer bait to food or food preparation areas.
- After a baiting program is complete remove all unused baits.
- Do not place on soft furniture, carpets, highly polished surfaces or other easily stained surfaces.
