

WHEN TO USE: Queensland and Mediterranean Fruit Flies can cause damage to fruit in a variety of fruit species. Cera Trap is suitable for use in Apples, Apricots, Blueberries, Cherries, Grapes, Grapefruit, Guava, Lemons, Limes, Mandarin, Mangoes, Oranges, Passionfruit, Pawpaw, Peaches, Pears, Plums, Nectarines

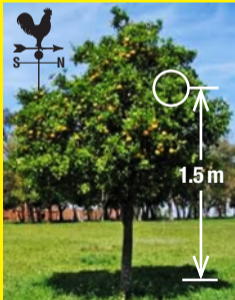
It is important to control fruit fly numbers before they start attacking the fruit. Cera Trap should be hung in trees when the fruit are small & still developing. Ideally hang the traps when fruit reaches approximately one third of its final size. Cera Trap will continue to work until the liquid has evaporated (usually 3 – 4 months depending on climate). If there is still fruit to be picked after all the liquid has evaporated, replace the trap with a new one.

HOW TO USE: Remove lid and carefully screw Cera Trap hanging apparatus directly onto bottle prior to hanging in tree. Attach Cera Trap to a branch in the tree canopy with wire or a cable tie. Avoid spilling any liquid on the outside of the bottle as this will attract the fruit flies to this area and they may not enter the trap.

One trap should be used for each fruit tree. Where two fruit trees are close together (no more than 5 metres apart) one Cera Trap can be used for both trees.

Traps should be placed on the northern side of the tree at a height of 1.5 m (approx chest height) from the ground - within the canopy and foliage of the tree.

For tall trees it may be necessary to place Cera Trap further from the ground to ensure it remains in the foliage.
