PICKUP: Can be used on hydraulic fluids, some petroleum products and organic pesticides, herbicides and insecticides. Deactivating turf herbicides: Apply to turf areas that have been treated by pre-emergent crabgrass and other organic herbicides whenever re-seeding is needed earlier than planned. Enhancing seed germination: When early germination and grass cover is needed **PICKUP** can enhance the germination of seed. Prepare seed bed as usual, then apply **PICKUP** at the rate of 1.9 Litres per 100 m² to the soil. Then proceed with seeding operation.

DIRECTIONS

For Spills: Apply 3.8 Litres per 100 m² of contaminated area. If spill is severe, apply full strength and wash into soil and root zone area 10-15 cm deep.

For Deactivating Turf Herbicides: Apply 3.8 Litres of **PICKUP** in sufficient water for good distribution per 100 m² of turf area. Grass areas should be washed free of heavy charcoal deposits. Areas where herbicide has been terminated may be seeded 24 hours after application.

For Sprayer Cleaning: After pesticide use, wash tank well with Tank Cleaner and rinse thoroughly. Fill spray tank halfway with water then add 2 Litres of **PICKUP** per 200 litres of water. Fill the remainder of spray tank with water and circulate through the system for 10 minutes. Drain system and rinse clean water until all signs of **PICKUP** are gone.

Storage and Disposal: Do Not Contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Invert stock periodically or reduce settling. Keep material from freezing.

General: For best results, agitation is recommended during the use of this product. If fine screens are used on spray nozzles, they should be removed prior to use of this product.
