## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Tracel is a soluble concentrated blend of trace elements which are essential to plant life. Tracel should be used in conjunction with or supplementary to normal fertilizers to balance and replace trace element deficiencies in the soil and thereby improve the quality of flowers, vegetables, fruit, shrubs, seedlings, orchids, orchards, ornamental trees, indoor plants, turf and all crops.

## GARDEN BEDS & VEGETABLES

Apply 100 grams per 10 m<sup>2</sup> (100 kg per ha) prior to planting. This can be broadcast or dissolved in a convenient volume of water and sprayed.

## FLOWERS, ORNAMENTALS, ORCHIDS, INDOOR PLANTS ETC.

Every 3 months sprinkle lightly around the edge of the pot or under the drip area of shrubs and trees and water in. Alternatively dissolve 30 grams in 10 litres of water in a watering can and water normally.

## TURF

Apply 1 kg in approximately 100 litres of water per 100 m<sup>2</sup> (15 kg in 1500 litres of water per bowling green) twice a year. If renovating it is recommended the Tracel be mixed with renovation fertilizers and apply dry while the ground is open.
